

Pediatric Neuropsychology Positions – San Diego

We are excited to announce 2 new openings for pediatric neuropsychologists to work with our existing team in San Diego. Advanced Neurobehavioral Health of Southern California (ANH; www.anhsocal.com) is a unique pediatric program in southern California that contracts with the local children's hospital, Rady Children's Hospital (www.rchsd.org), to provide neuropsychological evaluations to patients with a variety of medical conditions. Our relationship with the hospital has existed since 2013 and has grown consistently over time.

Presently, our team is contracted to provide outpatient evaluations in the hospital setting with several departments: Rehabilitation Medicine (<https://www.rchsd.org/programs-services/rehabilitation-medicine/>), Neurology (<https://www.rchsd.org/programs-services/neurology/>), and Hematology/Oncology (<https://www.rchsd.org/programs-services/cancer-blood-disorders/>). There will likely be future opportunities to develop inpatient programs and establish relationships with other departments as we continue to grow.

New team members will provide hospital based outpatient neuropsychological evaluations. Candidates should have experience in working with a wide range of neurodevelopmental and medical conditions (e.g., epilepsy and epilepsy surgery, concussion, TBI, cerebral palsy, spina bifida, movement disorders, Tourette syndrome, encephalitis, cancers, sickle cell disease).

Candidates must also be board certified or eligible for board certification in clinical neuropsychology with the expectation that subspecialty certification will be completed in pediatric neuropsychology through ABPP. Given our location in southern California, Spanish language fluency is preferable but not mandatory for the position.

Supervision and training opportunities are available as part of our formal APPCN member 2 year fellowship postdoctoral pediatric neuropsychology training program.

Our program emphasizes flexibility of scheduling and a strong work-life balance. Salary and benefits are competitive and commensurate with the cost of living in the San Diego region.

To apply, please submit a letter of interest that includes qualifications and career interests and goals, a CV, three letters of reference, and two sample clinical reports. Electronic submissions are preferred.
